- Government agency staff preparing a Regional Solicitation application
- Community organization representatives and government agency staff scoring applications

Participants will:

- Build a shared understanding of key community-centered transportation project concepts
- Explore challenges and strategies for centering community in transportation projects
- Prepare for how Community Considerations will be understood and discussed in the Regional Solicitation process
